## Tasks to Complete:

- 1. With your group, read through the lines provided for you in the script. Work in pairs to practice your lines. We do not have many speaking roles for this CAC performance. Make sure that you are emoting, or expressing the write tone for each line. We will have auditions for the roles Tuesday December 2nd.
- 2. Unfortunately not everyone can make this group. If I had 15 roles to hand out, I gladly would. Please do not take it personally if you do not get selected for a speaking role. We will have more need for extras as the time gets closer.
- 3. With your group, decide who should be the "project manager." This person will oversee each person's designs for costumes, and will be the one to go to should you have any ideas for script changes. If you DO have an idea for a script change, this must be presented to Ms. Pearse as soon as possible.
- 4. When you are ready to start designing costumes, please create full color sketches on blank computer paper. Write down the materials/items needed for each costume.
- 5. When the artist is here (three out of the 10 days) you will spend the entirety of the morning working on lines/practicing mannerisms.
- 6. What's most important to remember is that your position as an actor/actress is not guaranteed. If you are slacking off, running around, or just not focusing, you will be placed in another group, and someone will take your place.
