Tasks to Complete:

1. With your group, read through the lines provided for you in the script. Your task will be to create the "YouTube" video that we will play during the CAC Performance.
2. Complete a brainstorming sheet, with ideas of special shots you might want to do, angles, etc. Where do you want to shoot this? What equipment will you need? What other important information might be missing?
3. Create and outline a storyboard (as a group) that will help you organize your CAC video.
4. Aside from the CAC YouTube Video shoot, you will also be interviewing students about how social media affects them, ways they use it, how they see it being used by companies, and where they think it may be going in the next 10 years.

Come up with 10-13 questions to ask each interviewee. You must interview at least 8 students (one from each classroom), but you can choose to interview other people as well. This includes administrators, teachers, or even more kids. It is up to you!

5. Film all shots needed for the CAC Video, and Interview Videos.
6. Edit both videos, and make sure they are playable, and ready to go for the CAC show. These will be due by Wednesday December 10th.
7. What's most important to remember is that your position as an actor/actress is not guaranteed. If you are slacking off, running around, or just not focusing, you will be placed in another group, and someone will take your place.
